~ President's Message ~

Iwould like first to apologize for the “hiccup” that occurred involving the preparation and distribution of the 3rd quarter Freightliner Flyer. You might say that we encountered the “perfect storm” when it came to coordination between those responsible for getting the material together, layout, printing and distribution. In this particular case, illness involving a close family member of the team took precedent. However, all is not lost as the 3rd quarter Freightliner Flyer is posted on our website at www.fcocrv.org.

Looking back at the year, there were a number of significant events that are worth mentioning to the membership.

First, the Family Motor Coaching Association has changed their rules and will only conduct one Family Reunion & Motorhome Showcase a year, the next being the 87th Family Reunion in Indianapolis, Indiana, August 27 to 30, 2012. While FCOC will continue to have two (2) National rallies a year, we expect to conduct technical seminars involving the Freightliner chassis at both National rallies, but do not expect to have the FCCC Trailer with parts and technicians at both events

A second noteworthy event was the change to our Standing Rules affected during the Amana Colonies rally. Specifically, the membership voted that at least one (1) business meeting will be held during the fiscal year and that meeting will be held at the summer FMCA rally, with notice of meeting to be put in the convention schedule. We expect to have our club “pizza party” during the FMCA event, but not necessarily on the same day as the business meeting.

The last item involves our Bylaws. The FMCA National Bylaws require their committee to review all chapter Bylaws revisions and new chapter Bylaws. This is to ensure conformance with the FMCA National Bylaws and Policies and Procedures of FMCA contained in the Member and Volunteer Handbook. FMCA has reviewed our chapter Bylaws, found them to be in conformance and has accepted them for FMCA files on 3 October 2011. A copy of our approved Bylaws and Standing Rules can be found on our club website at www.fcocrv.org.

You will be reading this after the holidays have passed, and if you believed the early decorations and advertisements that bombarded us starting in early November, Christmas arrived early and Thanksgiving was just an event on the calendar before “Black Friday.” In any event, I want to take the opportunity to wish you and yours the very best for the coming year.

Fleetwood also introduced three new coaches, a front engine diesel version of the Bounder, a 33' Excursion, and a 38' American Coach Revolution, all on FCCC product.

Wander a little more and you would have seen Thor Motorcoach's new Palazzo built on FCCC's XCS chassis. As a matter of fact, if there was a new class A diesel product being introduced, whether it be a new coach or floor plan, it most likely was built on our chassis.

Also, recognizing the importance of the RV dealership experience, we launched our first ever Learning Management System (LMS) which is an on-line information and training resource dedicated to RV sales and technical personnel so they can better understand our product and services.

All in all, the show proved to be a smashing success for our company!

As for a look in the rear view mirror, we maintained our industry leading market share (51% YTD) and based on what you just read above, are well positioned to increase our share in 2012. And that's

not just in RV. We were able to maintain our leadership position in all our market segments and gain in a new one. After just one year of production we are now the market share leader with our Walk-in Van gas product.

Well, enough of that. Rest assured we will not relax as a result of our success, but instead continue to strive to provide the best RV experience in sales, service and product. Hermisia and I wish you a joyful holiday season and we look forward to seeing everyone in 2012.

FMCA CORNER

The Executive Board of FMCA has been very busy since the last FMCA CORNER went to print trying to find ways to stem the loss of present members and find other ways to recruit new members, while looking for ways to reduce spending. Brad Koshland as Executive Director has realigned the departments and department heads at the national office in Cincinnati OH, as follows: Jerry Yeatts moved from the Convention Department to the Membership/Member Services Department. The Convention Department has been restructured to include area rallies; the new name is Events and Commercial Services. Chris Lusk was named to head that department with the title of Events Manager. Carol Shields was moved from Chapter Services to Events. Brad also created a new position of Assistant Events Manager, that has been filled by Maureen Mullarkey. Loretta Buob has moved from Chapter Services to serve as Director of Accounting/Financial Services. Penny Gortemiller has stepped up to the position of Supervisor of Chapter, Area, and National Services. All of these moves have taken place with minimal or no financial impact to FMCA. With the elimination of some positions and the departure of Brad Koshland, the National Director, an approximate savings of \$268,000 to FMC will be realized.

Brad Koshland resigned as FMCA National Director with his last day being November 30, 2011. Jerry Yeatts has assumed the duties of National Director, and will continue to oversee Membership/Member Services as well.

Will Young's Treasurer's report states that FMCA investments were \$7,138,302. The prepaid expense at year-end was \$2,768,765, which is less than 2010 by \$961,233. The Perry Family Reunion in March showed a surplus of \$272,000. The Madison Family reunion showed a deficit of \$1,995. Magazine revenue for fiscal year 2011 was \$1,691,589, which was \$169,955 above 2010's revenue. FMCA is projected to show a profit of \$236,476 for fiscal year 2011. However, FMC Inc. is projected to show a loss of \$1,505,588. The combined projected loss for 2011 will be \$1,269,112.

Membership/Member Services in its effort to retain members sends an e-mail reminder first followed by a first renewal letter with membership card. A second letter is sent 45 days later, and final letter is sent 30 days after that. Then a "Last Issue" notice is placed in the final issue of Family Motor Coaching magazine the member will receive. Membership is also making an average of 1,400 phone calls each month to members for renewals. As of September, the Area Vice Presidents will be making the follow-up calls. In addition to these efforts, other membership programs have been implemented to help grow our membership. Some of these initiatives include: 1. Campground Connection--To date 146 campgrounds and resorts have signed up to be part of this program with 64 new campgrounds joining as commercial members. 2. Advertising Exchange Program. 3. Fantasy RV Tours. 4. G.R.O.W. Program, and 5. Dozen Does It Campaign. At the end of November FMCA's total membership is 86,781.

Benefits/Discounts: Over 200 members have taken advantage of the Michelin Advantage tire program. Fantasy RV Tours Tour Connection program is showing good success. FMCA recently renewed the agreement with Spatial Data Sciences Incorporated for trip routing. KOA has extended the free one-year membership to the KOA Value Kard Rewards Program. Sam's Club has extended until August 31, 2012 their offer of a \$10.00 gift card when you apply for or renew a Basic Advantage card, or a \$25.00 gift card when you apply for or renew an Advantage Plus card. You must present the Sam's Club certificate from the Family Motor Coaching magazine and your valid FMCA membership card to receive this offer. The Executive Board passed a motion to suspend all "Pre Diem" allowance for the Executive Board and the Board of Directors for a two-year period beginning immediately. National office staff traveling on company business and Executive Board members traveling by common carriage (air, train, etc.) rather than motorhome shall be entitled to per diem for travel days. The Executive Board also passed a motion to allow chapter officers to serve as officers in no more than two chapters, with the exception of national directors and alternate national directors.

Kathy and I hope you all have a very happy holiday season, and safe travels.



Spring In Tucson Rally



We are holding the Spring FCOC Rally in Tucson at the Lazydays RV Resort and dealership from March 5th - March 9th. For some that have been here before, this was the former Beaudry dealership and campground. Arrival will be on Monday, March 5th starting 12:00 noon. Leaving is scheduled the morning of March 9th before 11:00am. The registration fee will be \$300 which includes a campsite with full hook-ups for two occupants per coach, all seminars, entertainment, and dinners.
