



as I sit down to write this, we are about to leave Florida for Michigan and then on to Indiana for the FCOC National Rally in Elkhart and the FMCA 87th Family Reunion and Motorhome Showcase in Indianapolis.

The election results are in for FMCA's Area National Vice President. Alfred F. Vormittag will succeed Harry (Sonny) Gillespie as International Area National Vice President.

The spring meeting of the FMCA Executive Board was completed on May 15, 2012 at the National Office in Cincinnati, Ohio. The 2013 fiscal year budget was presented to and approved by Executive Board and it will be presented to the Governing Board at Indianapolis for final approval.

A report by the Evac Benefit Special Committee Chairman Russ Boyer, was given. Our current provider for FMCAssist is On Call. They have indicated that their program is not a good fit for FMCA, and thus FMCA's relationship with On Call will end on September 30, 2012. Ross stated he has received three replies to FMCA's requests for a proposal, with two more anticipated after June 1, 2012. A meeting of Roy Hopper the Executive Board will be held to review the proposals as soon as all are received. A member purchased program is also being considered. The current cost to FMCA for the FMCAssist program is approximately \$380,000 per year. With our decline in membership down to 84,556 as of the end of May, it is becoming extremely difficult to maintain this expense.

The computer system improvements are proceeding on schedule, with the membership department and associated IT

s I sit down to write this, we are about programs progressing. The entire upgrade to leave Florida for Michigan and then is expected to be completed by the end of Indiana for the FCOC National Rallu 2012.

FMCA national office has lost 10 full-time employees since November, 2011. FMCA has trimmed \$1,275,000 in expenses for a 12-month period; as a result, FMCA will realize a carryover of these savings into 2013 budget.

FMCA's Executive Board has hired an outside marketing firm, TPR Associates, to help turn around our loss of membership. It was felt that FMCA needed assistance in marketing ourselves to the current generation of motorhomers.

Don't forget the "A Dozen Does It" program is for FMCA's membership to grow. So when you see a motorhome in a campground without a goose egg on it, strike up a conversation and ask them to join FMCA. They will be glad they did.

Hope to see you all at the FCOC National Rally in Elkhart, August 20 to 24, 2012 and also at the 87th Family Reunion and Motorhome Showcase, August 27 to 30, 2012.



Members should visit <u>www.michelinrvtires.com</u> to locate an authorized Michelin RV tire dealer, to research tires, and to select the right tires for your motorhome. The tires listed on that site are included in the program.

FMCA members will always need to follow the <u>instructions</u> provided by FMCA in order for dealers to recognize them as Advantage Program members, including providing their FMCA membership number and expiration date.

Any fees for mounting, balancing, state and local taxes, and tire disposal are extra and quoted locally by the servicing dealer, so those fees are not included in the program.

The tire purchase must be paid for with a credit card — VISA, MasterCard or American Express — at the servicing dealership. Michelin's corporate office will charge the credit card the discounted price. FMCA will then send the member — via e-mail — a copy of the invoice that reflects the total with the Advantage Program tire price.
