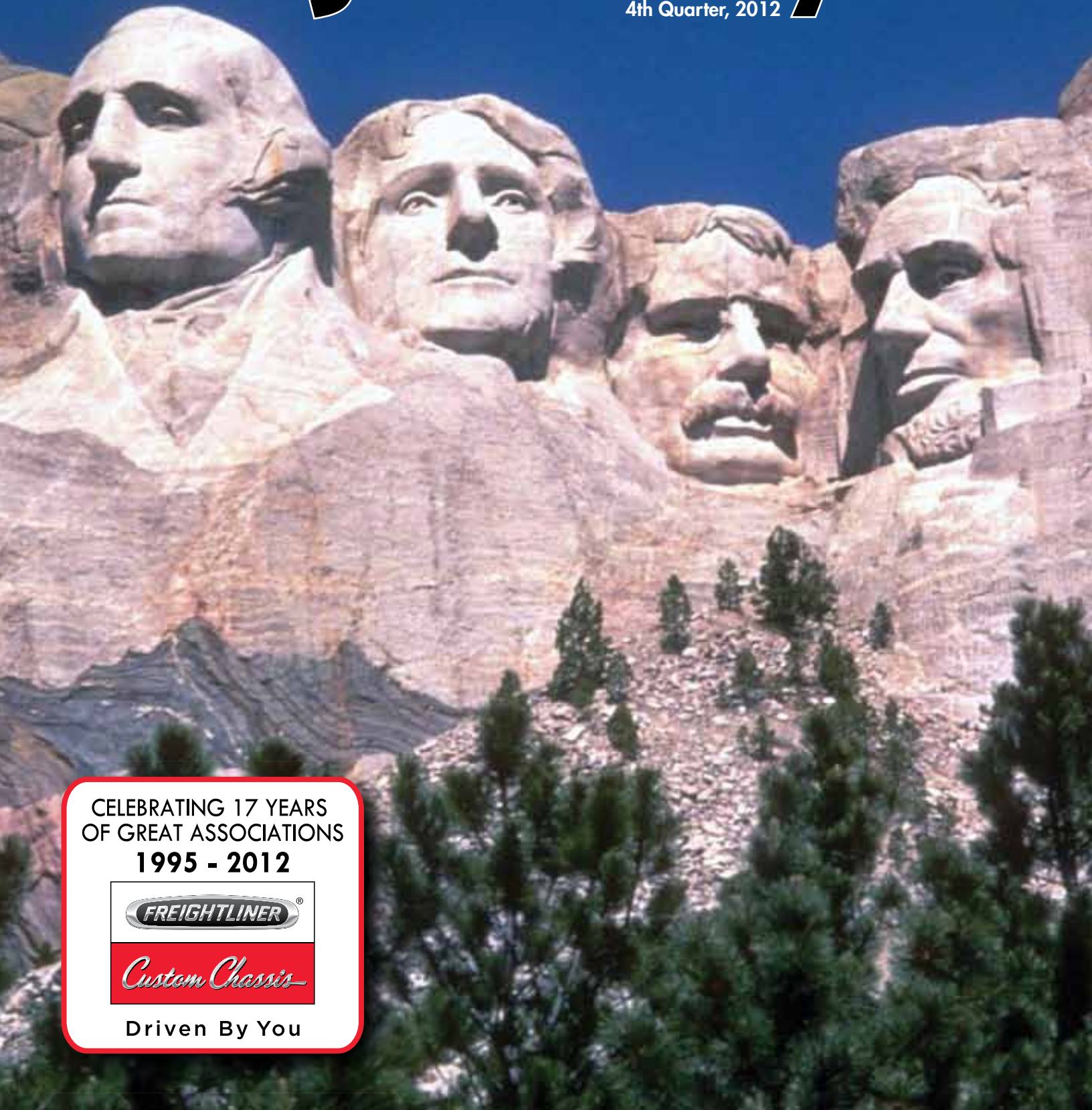

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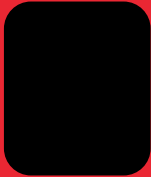

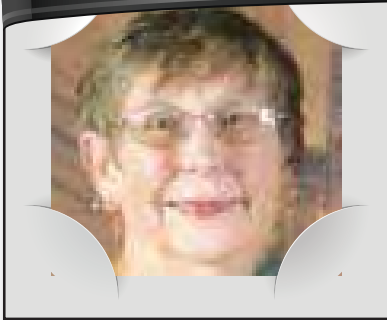

**CARAVANS** – Scheduled caravans of 10 coaches or more will be parked on Monday and Tuesday, June 17 and 18, 2013. Caravan leaders please call 800-543-3622 to schedule an arrival time.

**GENERAL PARKING** – Use of generator is only permitted from 6 a.m. to 11 p.m.

**HANDICAPPED PARKING\*\*** – Reserved for those with qualifying medical needs. Limited space. First registered/first served basis. Use of generator is only permitted from 6 a.m. to 11 p.m.

**HANDICAPPED W/ELECTRIC\*\*** – Reserved for those with qualifying medical needs who must operate equipment relative to treatment of their condition. Limited space. First registered/first served basis. Electric available at 9 a.m. on Tuesday, June 18, 2013, until 9 a.m. on Sunday, June 23, 2013. (electric fees apply)

**FULL GENERATOR** – Generator permitted 24 hours per day.

**NO GENERATOR** – Space is limited.

**FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN** – Generator 6 a.m. to 11 p.m. only.

**PASSPORT CAR PARKING** – Includes entertainment, exhibits and seminars. No overnight parking on event property. Passport coaches cannot be accommodated at the fairgrounds. Passport car parking will be open only until 11 p.m., June 18, 19, 20, 21, and 22, 2013. Public parking will be open only during exhibit hours, June 19, 20, 21, and 22, 2013.

## MAILING AND PARKING PROCEDURES FOR ALL PARKING AREAS

FMCA will begin mailing confirmations as soon as April 15, 2013. Mailed confirmations will contain “date of entry” credentials. Mailed registrations received after June 7, 2013, will be held and processed as gate registrations.

If it is impossible for you to furnish an address for receipt of your confirmation material, they will be held for you at Will Call located at the official Holding Area from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., Sunday, June 16, through Wednesday, June 19.

Registered family members will be assigned parking dates of Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday; June 17, 18, and 19, 2013.

Families should arrive at the convention on the date stated on their “date of entry” credentials. If you arrive at the convention on a date following your assigned date of entry, you may have to wait in the Holding Area to be parked.

Families registering on-site will be parked on June 19, between noon and 5 p.m.

If you have friends or relatives with whom you would like to park, make plans now to register with them. Families who register together and mail their registration forms to FMCA in the same envelope are guaranteed to receive identical “date of entry” credentials. You must arrive together to park together.

Family Reunion parking is considered any lot secured by FMCA. Members of FMCA's parking crew will be in the Holding Area from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. to park coaches. Tram service to all parking areas will be available beginning Tuesday, June 18.

If you are traveling as an individual, a group, or a caravan, confirmation “date of entry” credentials must be displayed on your motorhome to facilitate your entry into the grounds.

All members are asked to display their membership number on their coach or in their windshield.

## EARLY ARRIVALS

If you arrive prior to your date of admittance, as identified on your “date of entry” credential, dry camping will be available beginning on Sunday, June 16, in the Holding Area.

**Description:** We've made a major change to how your Member Profile is handled and what info we can store for you. You still use the same login (your FMCA number) and password as before.



What used to be called "Keep in Touch" has been renamed as "Member Profile", and now gives you a chance to improve how the Freightliner Chassis Owners Club can communicate with you. We encourage you to check out the information on file for you and your copilot and go back as needed to update that info.

You start by going to Membership on the menu, then select Update Member Profile. You will be asked to log in using your FMCA number - it will not let you forget to include the letter in front of the numbers - and the same password you used with the old system.

You be shown a screen that has your name, FMCA#, and expiration date and five main sections indicated by section headers. You can work in any of the sections in any order that you wish, and you save your changes section by section. And you can go back to any section even after you have left it. Simply click on the text in the header bar or the + sign symbol to open or close a section.

## Personal Information

This is where the most changes have been made. For one, you can now provide a seasonal address and let us know the starting and stopping dates for using that address. Any printed material will be sent to whichever address is active at the time of mailing. About three-fourths of the way down the form you will see a radiobutton choice to indicate if you only have one address or also have a seasonal address.

We have provided for you to give us your birthday, so we can perhaps send greetings or other communication appropriate for birthdays. You can give us just month and day, but can also provide the year if you wish.

In addition to your email address we also allow you to provide a Twitter address, a Facebook address, a Google+ address, a Skype address, and an address for your personal web site or blog. Though not used now, some of these may be used in the future.



## **Dave's Message** *continued*

### **Motorhome Information**

We still collect the same information about your motorhome and its ownership.

### **Preferences, Misc Info**

We still ask about whether you are interested in serving in FCOC leadership, rally master, and helping at rallies. Now we also give you a checklist of skills you would make available to the club similar to what has been on membership application forms. But now you can update this at any time in Member Profile.

We still ask if you wish to receive electronic communications from us and whether you wish to receive the quarterly Freightliner Flyer newsletter electronically or by mail. We strongly encourage members to receive this electronically because it saves us an immense cost.

Those who have an email address on file know that you have received more frequent emailings recently, and we expect this to continue. We will be revamping our emailing system soon as well. You can choose whether to receive these emails when they are issued or to only receive a weekly or monthly summary.

### **Membership Information**

This section is read-only, and shows you information about your membership such as your membership history (when you joined and when you last visited your Member Profile), your dues status, and your membership classification and status.

### **Summary, Application Form**

The final section lets you download a Member Data Form that shows all the information you have recorded. You can save this PDF file and/or print it for your records.

There is also a Submit button which you can use to send an updated Member Data Form to the club officers for their records.

### **Benefits to FCOC**

Among the benefits to FCOC with the new system is that the club now has better control over the membership database and can more easily (and less expensively) make changes to the system and what information can be stored. This flexibility will be used in the future to offer new features or services to our members.
