





The NTEA Work Truck Show shifted online this year, and we still enjoyed sharing our updates and hearing from others in attendance.



RUTHMERE MUSEUM: The historic Ruthmere campus features the Ruthmere mansion, known as the "Jewel of Indiana," as well as the Havilah Beardsley House and exquisite gardens. LOVER'S OAK: Located at the intersection of Albany and Prince Streets, this oak tree reportedly dates back to the 12th century. The trunk of the Lover's Oak is about 13 feet (goldenisles.com/listing/lovers-oak/60/)

HISTORIC RITZ THEATRE: This historic downtown theatre and art center has a little bit of everything-performing arts, films, exhibits and education programs. It was built in 1899 and was originally home to the Grand Opera House.

GEORGIA SEA TURTLE CENTER: This facility is Georgia's first sea turtle rehabilitation, research and education center which cares for sick and injured sea turtles. Visitors can explore the lives of sea turtles and also participate in activities like evening turtle walks. The Georgia Sea Turtle Center is located on Jekyll Island, a 20-minute drive from Brunswick.

The design of the XC chassis works in tandem with the Phaeton 40 IH floorplan to create even more basement storage space and easy cargo access.

SEASONAL ARTICLE: SIPRING CILICANING

Whether you spent the winter traveling or soon plan to embark on your first adventure of the year, the following spring-cleaning checklist was made for any kind of RV lifestyle!

Follow these tips and to keep your coach in its best shape.

WATER SYSTEM

Sanitize your RV's fresh water system – both the hot and cold sides. We recommend doing this at least twice a year, especially if you're full-timers. This will ensure your water is safe to drink.

Flush and clean the water heater with vinegar – scrubbing as needed to remove any built-up rust or scale.

INTERIOR

Replace the batteries in your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, and make sure the fire extinguishers are properly charged.



Rotate and vacuum your mattresses.

Scrub all appliances and counter surfaces, as well as bathroom fixtures.

EXTERIOR

Inspect the roof of your coach and all decor. NOTE: Every place there is something attached is a source of a potential leak. If you spot any cracking or wear, use the dicor to patch. It's best to prevent leaks before they start.

Use baby powder to lubricate slide-outs and keep them from sticking or tearing.

- Check the tires and wheels for any damage or wear. Look out for low tread, bent wheels, low tire pressure and any other irregular signs. We also recommend having them inspected by a professional every couple of years.
- Wash your RV, starting with the roof. Wax on liquid automotive wax and wax off with a microfiber cloth
- automotive wax and wax off with a microfiber cloth.
 Try washing first with the slide-outs in, then
 - Iry washing first with the slide-outs in, then wash them separately
 - Use a pressure washer to tackle areas like fiberglass roofs, mud flaps, screens, jacks, wheels and more. If your RV has a rubber roof, just make sure to dial down the pressure.

Examine your RV's tow bar. If it does not move easily in or out, apply fresh grease.



OTHER TASKS

Service the generator - in order to keep the cost down, make sure to perform quality inspection of and service to all of the following:

- Oil and filter change
- Clean spark arrestor
- Replace air filter

- Flush cooling system
- Replace fuel filter

Set up a new sewer hose each year - This is definitely one of those things you do not want to put off - replace it **BEFORE it starts leaking.**

Inspect the coach's batteries and service as needed. We recommend doing this monthly, especially for flooded lead acid batteries.



ROADSIDE IRICIEPIES

AIR FRYER CHICKEN PARMESAN

Prep time: 20 minutes Cook time: 10 minutes Servings: 4

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 large boneless chicken breasts
- Kosher salt
- Freshly ground black pepper
- 1/3 cup all-purpose flour
- 2 large eggs
- 1 cup panko bread crumbs
- 1/4 cup freshly grated Parmesan
- 1 tsp. dried oregano

- 1/2 tsp. garlic powder
- 1/2 tsp. crushed red pepper flakes
- 1 cup marinara sauce
- 1 cup shredded mozzarella
- Freshly chopped parsley, for garnish



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Butterfly the chicken breasts by cutting them in half widthwise to create 4 thin pieces of chicken. Season on both sides with salt and pepper.
- 2. For the dredging: Place flour in a shallow bowl and season with a large pinch of salt and pepper. Place eggs in a second bowl and beat. In a third bowl, combine bread crumbs, Parmesan, oregano, garlic powder and red pepper flakes.
- 3. Working with one piece of a chicken at a time, coat in flour, then dip in eggs, and finally press into panko mixture to evenly coat both sides.
- 4. Working in batches as necessary, place chicken in the air fryer basket and cook at 400° for 5 minutes on each side. Top chicken with sauce and mozzarella and cook at 400° for 3 minutes more or until cheese is melted.
- 5. Garnish with parsley and serve!

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 medium apples
- Cinnamon, to sprinkle

AIR FRYER APPLE CHIPS

Prep time: 5 minutes

Cook time: 15 minutes

Servings: 2

DIRECTIONS:

- . Preheat the air fryer to 300°.
- 2. Slice washed apples carefully using a mandolin to about 1/8" thick. Remove all seeds.
- 3. Once the air fryer is preheated, place the apple slices in the air fryer basket trying to overlap as little as possible. If using a small air fryer, you may prefer to cook them in batches.
- 4. Cook on 300° for 12-15 minutes, flipping the apples every 5 minutes of cooking time. Transfer to a cooling rack for 5 minutes. The apple chips will feel slightly soft when removed from the air fryer, but they will turn crisp while cooling. Enjoy!

SLOW COOKER CORN ON THE COB

Prep time: 5 minutes Cook time: 4 hours, 30 minutes Servings: 6-8

INGREDIENTS:

- 6-8 ears of corn
- 1 tablespoon melted butter
- Salt and pepper, to taste
- 6-8 bacon slices, cooked but not crisp

DIRECTIONS:

- For each corn cob, lay one square of aluminum foil on 1. the counter.
- Place one cob in the center of the foil, brush lightly 2. with butter, sprinkle with salt and pepper and place torn pieces of bacon on top. (You don't want the bacon to be crisp, as the remaining fat will flavor the corn as it cooks.)
- Place in slow cooker and repeat. 3.
- Cover and cook on low for about 4-1/2 hours, or on high 4. for about 2 to 2-1/2 hours.

TIP: Take your corn on the cob to the next level -Mexican Street Corn! Brush with mayonnaise, thoroughly coat with Cotija cheese, add some cilantro and sprinkle with chili powder. Squeeze a lime over the cobs, salt and enjoy!

HOT BACON CHEESE DIP

Prep time: 15 minutes Cook time: 2 hours Makes: 4 cups

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 packages (8 ounces each) cream cheese, cubed
- 4 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 cup half-and-half cream
- 2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce

DIRECTIONS:

- 1 teaspoon dried minced onion
- 1 teaspoon prepared mustard
- 16 bacon strips, cooked and crumbled
- Tortilla chips or French bread slices
- 1. Combine the first six ingredients in a 1¹/₂-quart slow cooker. Cover and cook on low for 2-3 hours - or until cheese is melted. Stir occasionally.
- 2. Just before serving, stir in bacon crumbles.
- 3. Serve warm with tortilla chips or bread.



TIP:

If you enjoy some heat, we recommend adding green chiles or jalapeños.

NOTE: Not all slow cookers/crock pots are created equal. Go by how yours has performed in the past.




