FCOC ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING MINUTES

Elkhart, Indiana | August 2021

The meeting was called to order at 9:05 a.m. by President James Peek. The pledge of allegiance was recited by all. FCOC officers in attendance were President, James Peek; Sr. Vice President, Roy Hopper; VP Business Development, Steve Bertling; VP Area Operations East, George Young; VP Membership, Mary Costigan; Treasurer, Tom Bernardi; Secretary, Pattee Perez; Editor, Cindy Feindel.

President James Peek spoke on the benefits and value for members to use the Freightliner website application and to download on your phone for any questions/information, and the importance to always use your FCOC number.

Treasurer Tom Bernardi gave the treasurers report, membership income is growing, it's up from \$32,000 to \$35,000. Biggest expense is the publication for the *RV Soul* which has a cost of \$9,000 per quarter. Current net worth as of end of June \$262,000, annual statement 2019-2020 year end is \$349,000 in cash, \$114,000 of that is deferred revenue.

President James Peek addressed the attending members that last year the board voted to make past president Steve Batorson a life time member. Since then, James had found out that the vote needed to come from the members not the board. Motion was made by Sally Bernardi to make Steve Batorson a life time member. Motion was seconded by Steve Jeanneret. Motion passed.

James asked that as of 2021 to make Barbara Knutson a life time member as a thank you for her 13 years of service. Motion was made by John Malin. Motion was seconded by Sally Bernardi. Motion passed.

Old Business

James Peek: Secretary report was published in the *RV Soul* a year and a half ago asked for motion to accept as printed motion made by Pat Leiss. Motion seconded by Bill Feindel. Motion passed.

New Business

Sr. Vice President Roy Hopper: Election of officers – following is the slate of officers to be elected: President–James Peek; Secretary–Pattee Perez; VP Membership–Mary Costigan; Webmaster–Jonathan Demarest; VP Operations West–Steve Jeanneret.

Sr. Vice President Roy Hopper asked if there were any nominations from the floor, there being none, Kent Gardner made a motion that the nominations be closed. Motion seconded by Sally Bernardi. Motion passed.

Kent Gardner made a motion to accept the slate of officers. Motion seconded by Sally Bernardi. Motion passed.

Roy reported that he is looking for locations for rallies that have 100 RV spaces and a building that can hold 200 people, asked that members check out the campgrounds they stay at. If you obtain any information email or give Roy a call.

We are also looking for Rally Masters and Asst. Rally Masters. First time volunteer Rally masters start out being Asst. Rally Masters along with Rally masters with

experience, both Rally Masters and Asst. Rally Master, will have their rally fees paid by the club as well as a percentage of their fuel cost to and from their home base.

THINGS TO DO AND SEE IN BRUNSWICK

LOVER'S OAK: Located at the intersection of Albany and Prince Streets, this oak tree reportedly dates back to the 12th century. The trunk of the Lover's Oak is about 13 feet in diameter and it branches into ten limbs.

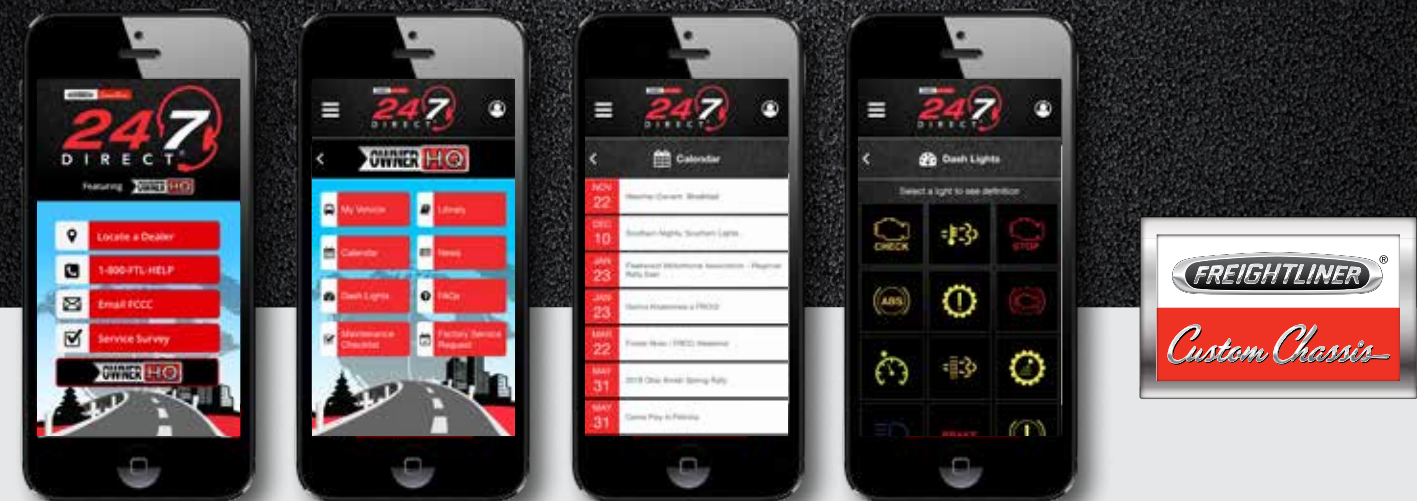

- 2 to 2 ¼ cups bell pepper (red, green and/or yellow), diced
- 2 teaspoons Italian seasoning
- 2 cups beef broth
- 1 can (14 ½ ounces) diced tomatoes, undrained
- 1 ½ cups tomato sauce
- 3 tablespoons tomato paste
- 1 cup basmati rice, uncooked
- 1 cup mozzarella cheese, shredded
- Salt and pepper to taste

DIRECTIONS:

1. In medium to large skillet, brown beef with onion and garlic until no pink remains. Drain excess fat.
2. Add diced peppers, seasoning, beef broth, tomatoes, tomato sauce, tomato paste and salt and pepper.
3. Bring mixture to a boil, reduce heat to a simmer and cover. Simmer 25 minutes or until rice is tender. (Add more broth if needed.)
4. Once rice is tender, top with cheese and cover with a lid until melted.

- 3 tablespoons olive oil
- 2 teaspoons garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon onion powder
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 2 teaspoons Italian seasoning
- 1 pound boneless, skinless chicken breasts

Wraps

- 4 large whole-wheat tortillas
- ½ cup hummus (store bought)
- 1 cup lettuce (iceberg, romaine or your favorite)
- 1 large tomato sliced
- ½ cup cucumber thinly sliced
- ¼ cup red onion thinly sliced
- ¼ cup feta cheese

DIRECTIONS:

1. Using a zester or grater, grate zest from lemon. Slice lemon in half and add juice to zest in a large, sealable plastic bag.
2. In the same bag, combine olive oil and seasoning. Add chicken and make sure it's all covered by marinade. Seal bag and let marinate for at least 30 minutes.
3. Remove chicken from bag, discard marinade. Grill chicken on medium-high heat until cooked through, 5 to 7 minutes on each side.
4. Remove chicken from grill and slice thinly.
5. Lay tortillas flat and spread with hummus. Top with lettuce, grilled chicken, tomato, cucumber, red onion, and feta cheese.
6. Rollup and wrap tortilla tightly. Slice in half and serve.

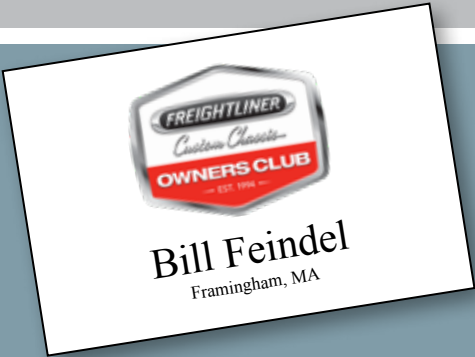


