SERVICE UPDATE



OVERLOOKED MAINTENANCE ITEMS

When it comes to RV maintenance, we've learned that a few items tend to get overlooked—the first of these is the air dryer filter.

For many owners, it might just be neglected because it's "out of sight, out of mind." But, the air dryer filter actually needs to be replaced every 3 years or at 36,000 miles. Its most common location is inside the rail, just aft of the drive axle on the left side of the coach.

The second most commonly overlooked maintenance item we see is the engine air cleaner filter.

Here's why: the air filter has a vacuum indicator that tells you when a filter has too much dirt to be efficient. If that vacuum indicator shows the levels are good, you may make the mistake of not changing the filter every two years. Take this as a reminder to check and see if your engine air cleaner filter needs replaced.

The third top maintenance item to remember is oil—oil change, oil filters and fuel filters. These items need to be replaced once a year, or every 15,000 miles. Also be sure to check your generator filter once a year.

Depending on your RV, you may be able to access Transmission Prognostics from your vehicle configuration menu in the cockpit. This will display oil levels, oil filter status and oil life.

Just remember the 1-2-3 rule of the top maintenance items, and you'll be set for the road ahead:

- 1 EVERY YEAR: OIL, OIL FILTERS, FUEL FILTERS**
- 2 EVERY TWO YEARS: ENGINE AIR CLEANER FILTER**
- 3 EVERY THREE YEARS: AIR DRYER FILTER**



HEALTHY LIVING ON THE ROAD

WITH RUSS AND DIANE BARBERIO

In these times of soaring chronic diseases (type 2 diabetes, covid, cancer, heart disease), especially as we RVers get older, we need to live as healthy as we can on the road.

Almost two years ago, Diane and I knew we had to make a change. I was always well over 200 pounds and Diane was approaching an unhealthy number as well. Like most people who tried to lose weight, we started many kinds of diets. While they somewhat worked at first, it wouldn't be long before we weighed more than when we started.

In the fall of 2019, we were well into the "Apple Fritter Diet" (the ones from QT gas stations were the best). Given the fact there are no QT stations within 250 miles of where we live, we thought it was a good time to try something real.

First "Paleo," then "Keto" were our choices. We faithfully stuck with it for a year. 2020 ended with me losing pounds and Diane losing 20. It was not as much a diet as it was a lifestyle change. One year later, instead of gaining weight back, we have continued to lose a few more pounds.

Lifestyle changes are different for different people. For us it means:

- Eating "healthy." This certainly will vary from person to person. We eat high fat and low to moderate carbohydrates. Even "low to moderate" will be counted differently for every body, so it's important to do your own research.
- Intermittent fasting—for us it means eating twice a day. It is hard at first, but we promise it gets easier. Just think about it: You don't always have to stop to find a restaurant for lunch on the road.
- Reducing alcohol intake. Wine seems to taste even better this way. This may require a little research as well.
- Exercising. Do whatever you can. For us it is some yoga, some walking, some resistance training (Believe me... it's not much)
- Learning all we can about "healthy living."





Here's what we do to achieve this healthier way of living:

- Eat two meals a day within 6 hours
- Bake our own bread. We grind our own wheat using a MockMill wheat grinder. The bread is 100% whole wheat. We use a bread machine (Zojirushi). Yes, this method would be abhorred by bread purists; however, this can be done on the road.
- Roast our own green coffee (Genuine Origin). Not for everyone, but we know what is in it and we save a lot of money. We certainly grind our own coffee (Oxo grinder without the scale).
- Eat a moderate amount of meat including red meat. We believe there are certain nutrients that, *in our opinion*, can't be obtained any other way.
- Curtail intake of wine. This was Russ' lifestyle change, Diane didn't drink that often to begin with.
- Stay away from fast food restaurants. They disguise the food they call "healthy." *In our opinion* it is all unhealthy. In fact, we stay away from *all* restaurants as much as we can.
- Avoid un-natural foods. This includes any food that says it is low fat, diet, keto, or sugar free. We also stay away from disguised high sugar foods such as fruit juices, flavored yogurts and anything sweet.
- Make and eat our own bacon using pork belly from Costco. Again, it's not for everyone, but it's what we do.
- Smoke or roast, flavor, and eat nuts. Our favorites are almonds and pecans. We use a portable Traeger pellet smoker grill for the bacon and nuts. Anything cooked on the Traeger tastes great.
- Walk as much as we can.
- Do a 20-minute (easy) yoga routine several times a week (we recommend Rodney Yee's Morning Yoga).
- This next one is not for everyone: We take a hot (112 degrees) soak for 6 to 10 minutes several times a week. We have a Japanese style Furo in our bathroom that filters and heats the water to a constant temperature. Obviously, this can't be done on the road. A sauna could be a substitute...maybe there is a "roadie" sauna out there. Tell us if you know of one.
- Listen and learn from books on the road (Audible) to improve our lives. Since we have been RVing, we have listened to over 100 books and many are about healthy eating.

HOLIDAY CRINKLE COOKIES

Prep time: 30 min Cook time: 10-15 minutes Servings: 40 cookies

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 cup unsweetened cocoa powder
- 2 cups granulated sugar
- 1/2 cup vegetable oil
- 4 eggs
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup confectioner's sugar

DIRECTIONS:

1. In a medium bowl, mix the cocoa, granulated sugar and vegetable oil.
2. Beat in eggs one at a time and stir in vanilla.
3. In a separate large bowl, combine the flour, baking powder, and salt; then stir into the cocoa mixture.
4. Preheat the oven to 350° F.
5. Line the baking sheet with parchment paper and roll the dough into 1-inch balls.
6. Coat each ball with confectioners sugar before placing on the baking sheet.
7. Bake for 10 to 12 minutes.
8. Transfer cookies to a wire rack to cool. Enjoy!

GREEN BEAN SALAD

Prep time: 15 min Cook time: 5 minutes Servings: 4-6

DIRECTIONS:

1. Bring a large pot of water to a boil and set a bowl of ice water nearby. Drop the green beans into the boiling water and blanch for 2 minutes. Remove the beans and immediately immerse in the ice water long enough to cool completely, about 15 seconds. Drain and place on paper towels to dry.
2. Transfer the beans to a bowl and toss with the radicchio, onion and a few spoonfuls of the dressing.
3. Arrange on a platter and top with small dollops of goat cheese, the walnuts, almonds and tarragon. Drizzle with more dressing, season to taste with flaky salt and serve.


