#### **Hemet Rally Canceled: From Rally Master Mary Costigan**

We have received many calls regarding information on the rally information in the 2021 Winter RV Soul regarding Spring Rally in Hemet California in April, 2022. We have had to cancel that rally due to charges outlined to us that would have put our four-day rally in the \$800 range. It was going to run \$50-60 dollars per person, per day for meals. On top of that, because of the restrictions in seating, we would not have been able to get more than 30 coaches with 2 people with the 6' space requirement between attendees. That means we could only get 2 or 3 people per table. The setup did not look like it would work out.

We know how important it is for us to get a rally together for the West Coast, but found it impossible to find a resort that would either allow 100+coaches, or would even call us back. However, we promise, if the restrictions are lifted for the 2023 spring season, that we will do everything we can, to get a West Coast Rally put together. Keep your fingers crossed.

The past few months have been busy ones for our team. We had the fortune of visiting with many of you at the Tampa RV Supershow in January. The Super Show featured huge crowds, lots of enthusiasm – and some exciting new products powered by FCCC.

This includes the new Tiffin Allegro Bay, which is built on our S2RV Super C chassis. The "adventure-ready" Allegro Bay is Tiffin's first entry into the rapidly growing Super C market and joins a growing lineup of models available on S2RV, including products from Entegra, Jayco and Renegade. The S2RV provides an exciting transition for customers coming in from a gas product who want the horsepower, fuel economy and torque of a diesel product.

We've also partnered with Forest River on the Charleston, its new 36-foot Class A luxury product designed and developed to meet growing demand for high-end coaches at the smaller end of the Class A market. Riding on an FCCC XCR raised-rail chassis, the Charleston is the only 36-foot coach on the market with a 15,000-lb. towing capacity, three-stage engine brake and 100-gallon fuel tank. The XCR enables the Charleston to offer high-end features not generally seen in a shorter Class A, including our full suite of RoadWatch safety features, OptiView digital dash, and BrakeSync, the only factory-installed, factory-warranted integrated air supply for tow vehicle brake system on an FCCC chassis.

Speaking of RoadWatch, we were thrilled to share the news in Tampa that its safety features are becoming standard in the 2023 model year with several OEMs. RoadWatch features include adaptive cruise control, stability controls, collision mitigation and automatic traction control. It also features the 360-degree Mobileye camera system, which offers real-time headway warning distance, intelligent high-beams, lane departure warnings and speed limit indicators to provide extra confidence to drivers in everyday driving situations. It integrates seamlessly with FCCC's OptiView digital dash, the industry's first fully integrated, all-digital LCD instrument cluster.

As you can see, it's shaping up to be an exciting year for FCCC - and we hope it's an enjoyable and memorable one for you as well. As always, our team remains focused on providing you the best ownership experience possible.



# FREIGHTLINER Custom Chassis\_

#### **OVERLOOKED MAINTENANCE ITEMS**

When it comes to RV maintenance, we've learned that a few items tend to get overlooked—the first of these is the air dryer filter.

For many owners, it might just be neglected because it's "out of sight, out of mind." But, the air dryer filter actually needs to be replaced every 3 years or at 36,000 miles. Its most common location is inside the rail, just aft of the drive axle on the left side of the coach.

The second most commonly overlooked maintenance item we see is the engine air cleaner filter.

Here's why: the air filter has a vacuum indicator that tells you when a filter has too much dirt to be efficient. If that vacuum indicator shows the levels are good, you may make the mistake of not changing the filter every two years. Take this as a reminder to check and see if your engine air cleaner filter needs replaced.

The third top maintenance item to remember is oil-oil change, oil filters and fuel filters. These items need to be replaced once a year, or every 15,000 miles. Also be sure to check your generator filter once a year.

Depending on your RV, you may be able to access Transmission Prognostics from your vehicle configuration menu in the cockpit. This will display oil levels, oil filter status and oil life.

Just remember the 1-2-3 rule of the top maintenance items, and you'll be set for the road ahead:

- 1 **EVERY YEAR: OIL, OIL FILTERS, FUEL FILTERS**
- 2 **EVERY TWO YEARS: ENGINE AIR CLEANER FILTER**
- 3 **EVERY THREE YEARS: AIR DRYER FILTER**



# PLAN YOUR NATIONAL PARK RV TRIP

This season is the perfect time of year to begin planning your summer and fall RV road trips. Summer time and early fall tend to be the peak seasons for many of the national parks here in the U.S. Planning your trip further in advance will help you make sure you get to visit all the places you want—while parking your RV safely and comfortably.

National parks are popular destinations for many campers, and for good reason—their picturesque views and outdoor opportunities are unmatched. But, we don't recommend that you just pack up and go—many national parks have length restrictions for RVs and their towed vehicles. It's also wise to look into their camping amenities in advance to make sure you have access to everything you'll need. Keep in mind that camping in a national park is not your only option if you do want to visit, as there are nearby campgrounds outside of parks as well.

Check out the table below to learn about acceptable RV lengths at national parks by state. And remember that some length restrictions may include your towed vehicle.



#### AIR FRYER CHEESY BREAKFAST EGG ROLLS

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 1/2 pound bulk pork sausage
- 1/2 cup shredded sharp cheddar cheese
- 1/2 cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese
- 1 tablespoon chopped green onions
- 4 large eggs

- 1 tablespoon 2% milk
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 12 egg roll wrappers
- Cooking spray
- Optional: maple syrup or salsa

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

- In a small skillet, cook sausage over medium heat until completely browned (about 4-6 minutes); drain. Stir in cheeses and green onions; set aside. Wipe skillet clean.
- In a small bowl, whisk eggs, milk, salt and pepper until blended. In the same skillet, heat butter over medium heat. Pour in egg mixture; cook and stir until eggs are thickened and no liquid egg remains. Stir in sausage mixture.
- 3. Preheat air fryer to 400° F. With 1 corner of an egg roll wrapper facing you, place 1/4 cup filling just below center of wrapper. (Cover remaining wrappers with a damp paper towel until ready to use.) Fold bottom corner over filling; moisten remaining wrapper edges with water. Fold side corners toward center over filling. Roll egg roll up tightly, pressing at tip to seal. Repeat.
- 4. In batches, arrange egg rolls in a single layer on greased tray in air-fryer basket; spritz with cooking spray. Cook until lightly browned, 3-4 minutes. Turn; spritz with cooking spray. Cook until golden brown and crisp, 3-4 minutes longer. If desired, serve with maple syrup or salsa.

# BERRY CHOCOLATE POUND CAKE SKILLET

Prep time: 10 min Cook time: 10 minutes Servings: 4-6

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 12-16 oz fresh berries
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 1/4 cup butter
- 3/4 lb pound cake
- 2 Rolo candy bars (or chocolate of your choice)

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Combine the berries and the sugar in a bowl and let sit until the juices start to release, 10-15 minutes. Cut the pound cake into 1" cubes.
- 2. Place a grate over hot coals, or heat up your grill. Add the butter to a 12" cast iron skillet and allow to melt. Add the pound cake to the hot skillet and cook, turning often, until all sides are toasted. Remove the skillet from the heat.
- 3. Sprinkle the berries over the top of the cake cubes, then the chocolate over the top. Cover the skillet with foil and allow to sit until the berries are warm and the chocolate is melted to your desire, or about 5-10 minutes.



## ONLINE MEMBERSHIP UPDATE OR RENEWAL

Anyone can access our website without logging in by going to www.FCOCRV.org. - Complete your payment information and follow instructions to submit.

#### **TO PAY DUES:**


