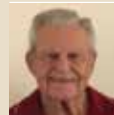

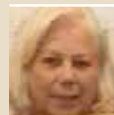

I have received many emails and phone calls from members unable to log on to their Member’s Profile or pay their dues through the PayPal / Credit Card site. We have had a problem with the PayPal site for quite a while, but hopefully this will help renew your memberships without issues.

When you want to log on to our website, go to fcocrv.org and at the top of the page it asks if you want to Sign-In or Join FCOC. Once you have established your Member Profile, the next time you log on to the FCOC website, it will have many choices, including a “Renew/Pay Dues” option. Be sure when it asks for your USERNAME that you put in your Member ID – that is your USERNAME. Also, please confirm all your Member Profile information is updated. We receive a lot of mailed newsletters and emails sent back because our members have forgotten to update their address or email on their profiles.

We have been told numerous times that when our member goes to pay their dues on the PayPal/Credit Card site, they will get a blue circle going round and round, and nothing is happening. Sometimes, depending on when during the day a member goes to pay their dues it is usually during the busiest part of the day for the website – it is recommended that you either try early in the morning, or later in the evening. To renew and pay your dues on our website you can use your personal credit card OR your PayPal account. That option is available if you scroll all the way down at the bottom of the page.

If this still doesn’t work, the other option is to send a check. Just so you know, we give our members a 3-month grace period from the date of their expiration, so you have plenty of time to get your membership updated before it goes into “CANCELED”. 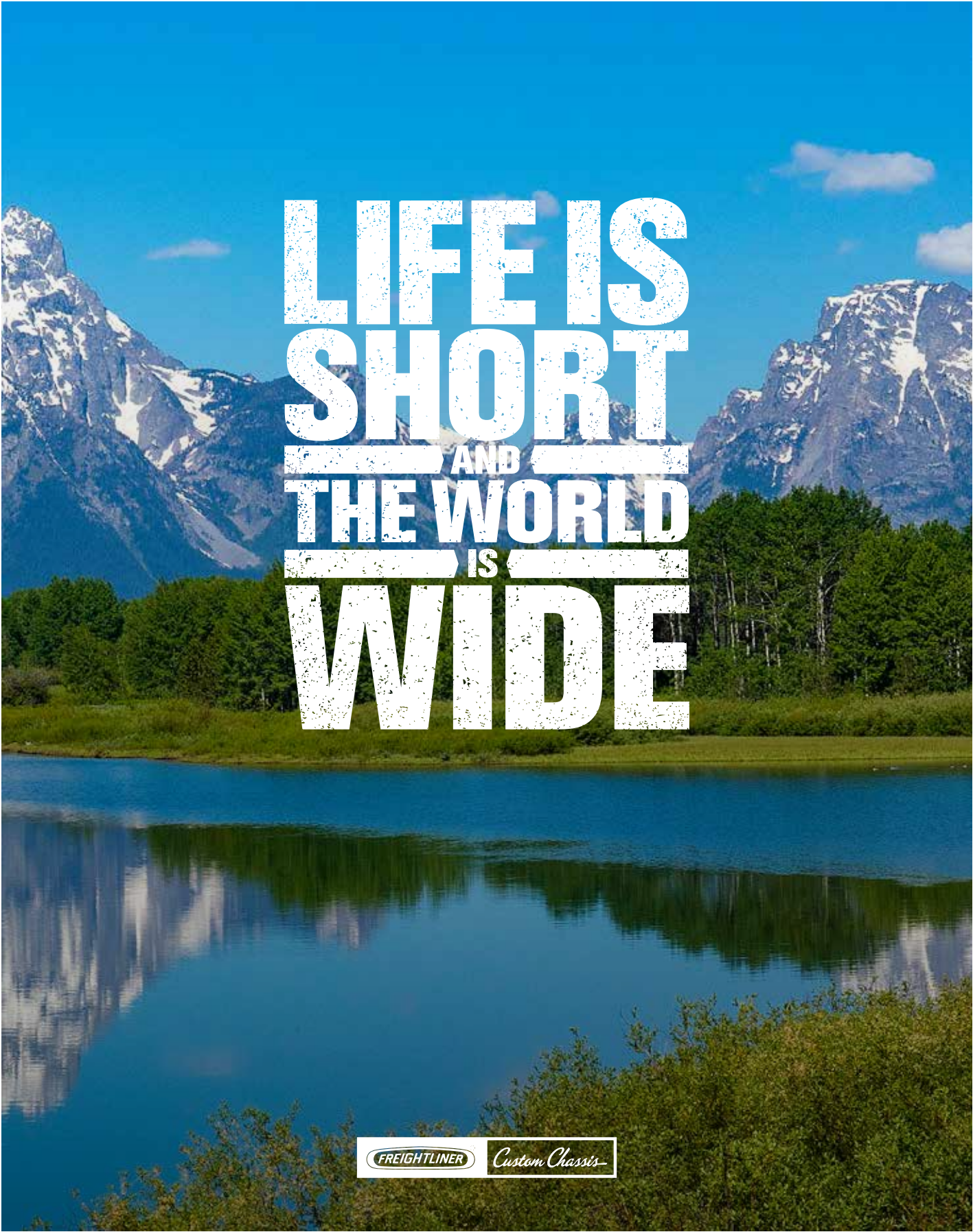

2023 JUNE ELKHART RALLY AND BUSINESS MEETING

Freightliner Chassis Owners Club would like to invite our members to Northeast Indiana for our annual membership meeting and election of officers to be held at the Elkhart Campground, 25608 County Road 4 East, Elkhart, Indiana, June 26-30, 2023.

The event fee of \$425.00 will include 50 amp full hookup pull thru solid sites. The cost for one in a unit is \$335.00, and add \$135.00 for each additional person staying within a members coach. Included in this fee are four nights of camping, four catered dinners, four breakfasts, entertainment, a ladies outing, 50/25/25 drawings, vendor seminars, a Freightliner Service Tech to answer your questions, and a charity auction. We are also hoping to bring a local Freightliner Oasis Dealer on board for service appointments.

Camp Freightliner will be held on Saturday and Sunday, June 24-25, prior to the rally. You must be registered for the rally in order to be eligible to attend Camp Freightliner. Details on how to enroll for the class will be included in your confirmation letter if you state that you would like to attend. There is an additional charge for Camp Freightliner.

Northeast Indiana is home to many motor home manufacturers so if you need service, call to get those appointments now.

SERVICE UPDATE

An update to our members from Steve Bertling, VP Business Development

The Oasis Program is Freightliner Custom Chassis Corporation's (FCCC) effort to provide its customers with the highest quality service for their coaches. The program has always provided trained service technicians to work on your coach chassis as the minimum a dealer would need to be certified as an Oasis dealer.

I recently spoke at length with Steve Horton of FCCC about the Oasis program. Steve is one of two District Service Managers at FCCC. He and his counterpart, Joel Rhinehardt, are responsible for certifying dealerships as well as overall management of the Oasis Program. Steve handles the Eastern US and Joel the Western US.

Steve and Joel are actively soliciting Freightliner Truck dealerships to join the Oasis Program. As a result, the network continues to grow nationwide.

Additionally, the minimum requirements for amenities to be provided by an Oasis dealer have been expanded to include:

- (2) functioning 50amp services in the RV parking area
- Signage directing customers upon entry
- Use of interior coach protection – floor mats, seat covers, steering wheel covers, booties, etc.
- A dump station plan. Simple one-pager directing customers to the closest dump facility, if one is not available on-site.
- Clean, modern lounge area with access to refreshments and free WiFi. (Does not have to be separate.)

SEASONAL ARTICLE

PLANTS: A GOOD WAY TO GO GREEN

Houseplants are wonderful additions to any indoor living space. They release oxygen to purify the air, bring the outdoors in, and brighten up the room with vibrant greens and freshness. When you're looking for indoor plants for your recreational vehicle, though, you'll want to take extra care in selecting plants hardy enough to stand up to life on the road. You'll also want plants that are safe around kids and animals—some popular ones are toxic, like the snake plant and peace lily. Here are relatively low-maintenance options that are family-friendly, tend to travel well, and thrive under most conditions:

1. Spider Plant

Requires low light, water once a week and trim dead leaves. Propagate "babies" into new plants by trimming, soaking in water and planting in soil once white roots grow.

2. Bamboo Palm

Low light, water when soil is dry, remove brown leaves.

3. Air Plants (tillandsia)

No soil needed! Just submerge in water for a few hours every week or so.

4. Kitchen Herbs (rosemary, mint, basil, lemongrass, thyme)

Indirect light, windowsill if possible, water weekly. Aromatic and also double-duty for use in cooking!



ROADSIDE RECIPES



NO BAKE BUTTERSCOTCH AND PEANUT BUTTER BIRD'S NEST COOKIES

Total time: 17 minutes Servings: 6 cookies

INGREDIENTS:

- ¾ cup butterscotch chips
- ½ cup smooth peanut butter
- 2 cups chow mein noodles
- ¼ cup chocolate eggs
(such as Cadbury mini eggs)

DIRECTIONS:

1. Melt the butterscotch chips with the peanut butter in a wide saucepan over low heat. Stir continuously until melted.
2. Pour the mixture into a large bowl of the chow mein noodles and stir to combine.
3. Fill up each compartment of a muffin tray with a spoonful of this mixture. (Note: to aid in removal of the cookies when set, use a silicone muffin tray or line your muffin tray with cupcake liners).
4. Let cool for 10 minutes and remove from the tray. Be careful when you are removing the nests, as to not break them.
5. Add in some chocolate Easter eggs (author used Cadbury mini eggs).

EASY BATTER FRUIT COBBLER

Prep time: 20 min Cook time: 10 minutes Servings: 4

INGREDIENTS:

- 4 tablespoons butter
- ¾ cup all-purpose flour
- ¾ cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- ¾ cup milk
- 2 cups of sliced fresh peaches or nectarines, or whole blueberries, strawberries, raspberries, blackberries or a combination of fruits (or a 12-ounce package of frozen berries)
- 1 tablespoon sugar

DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Adjust the oven rack to the upper-middle position.
2. Put butter in an 8-inch square or 9-inch round pan; place in the oven until butter is melted. Remove the pan from the oven and set aside.
3. Whisk flour, ¾ cup sugar, baking powder, and salt in a medium bowl. Whisk in milk until a smooth batter forms.
4. Pour batter into the prepared pan with melted butter.
5. Scatter fruit over batter. Sprinkle with 1 tablespoon sugar.
6. Bake in the preheated oven until the top is lightly browned and fruit bubbles, 50 to 60 minutes. Serve warm or at room temperature.

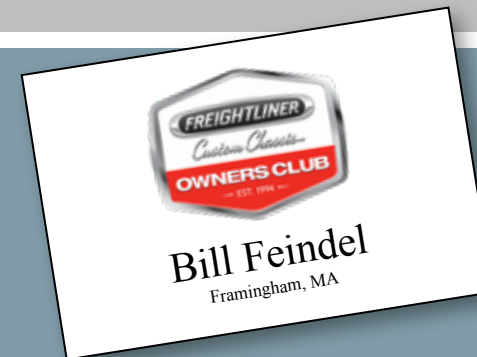

ONLINE MEMBERSHIP UPDATE OR RENEWAL
