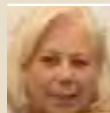

RALLY RECAP

MARCH RALLY

Natchez or Vidalia? Mississippi or Louisiana? Where are we anyway? We are at the Freightliner rally with the Jeannerets and Hoppers as rally hosts. Spanning the Mississippi River, the campground and activities were in Vidalia, LA; however, our tour on Thursday took us to Natchez, MS. But, I am getting ahead of myself, so let's get back to the beginning.

The rally started on March 20 with 65 motorhomes attending. It was kicked off with a welcome, first-timer orientation, presentation on what to do in Natchez, social hour, charity donation presentation, and delicious dinner of pork tenderloin and all the fixings. After dinner we played a game of Left, Right, Center. Each player started with 6 quarters. A player rolled 3 dice with R, L, and C on them. INSTANT POT MAC-N-CHEESE

Total time: 10 minutes Servings: 6-8

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 pound uncooked elbow pasta
- 4 cups water
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 3 tablespoons butter, cut into small pieces
- 2 1/2 cups shredded cheese up to 1/2 cup whole milk

DIRECTIONS:

1. Put the pasta, water, and salt into the instant pot. Cook for 4 minutes using the manual function. Quick release the steam so your noodles don't get overcooked.
2. Gently stir in the butter until melted.
3. Add the cheese and milk (use 2-3 tablespoons of milk at a time, as needed, up to 1/2 cup). Add more seasoning or liquid if necessary.
4. For best results, let it sit for 5-10 minutes to let it thicken up a bit.

INSTANT POT CARNITAS

Prep time: 20 min Cook time: 10 minutes Servings: 4

INGREDIENTS:

| - 2 tablespoons brown sugar | - 2 teaspoons salt, divided |
| - 1 tablespoon ground cumin | - 1 1/2 cups orange juice |
| - 1 tablespoon onion powder | - 1 lime |
| | - 2 tablespoons chopped cilantro |

DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut the pork shoulder into 2 inch cubes and place in the pot of an electric pressure cooker.
2. Sprinkle with the brown sugar, cumin, onion powder, garlic powder, and 1 teaspoon of salt. Stir to coat the meat. Pour in the orange juice.
3. Place the lid on the pressure cook and set vent to sealing.
4. Cook on high pressure for 27 minutes. Let pressure release naturally, about 15 minutes.
5. Remove the pork from the liquid and shred with two forks.
6. Place meat on a metal cookie sheet and squeeze lime juice over the top of the meat. Sprinkle with the remaining salt. Taste and add additional salt, if needed.
7. Place under the broiler until meat is crisp on the edges, about 5 minutes, stirring occasionally.
8. Sprinkle meat with cilantro and serve as a filling for tacos, in a burrito, or over rice.

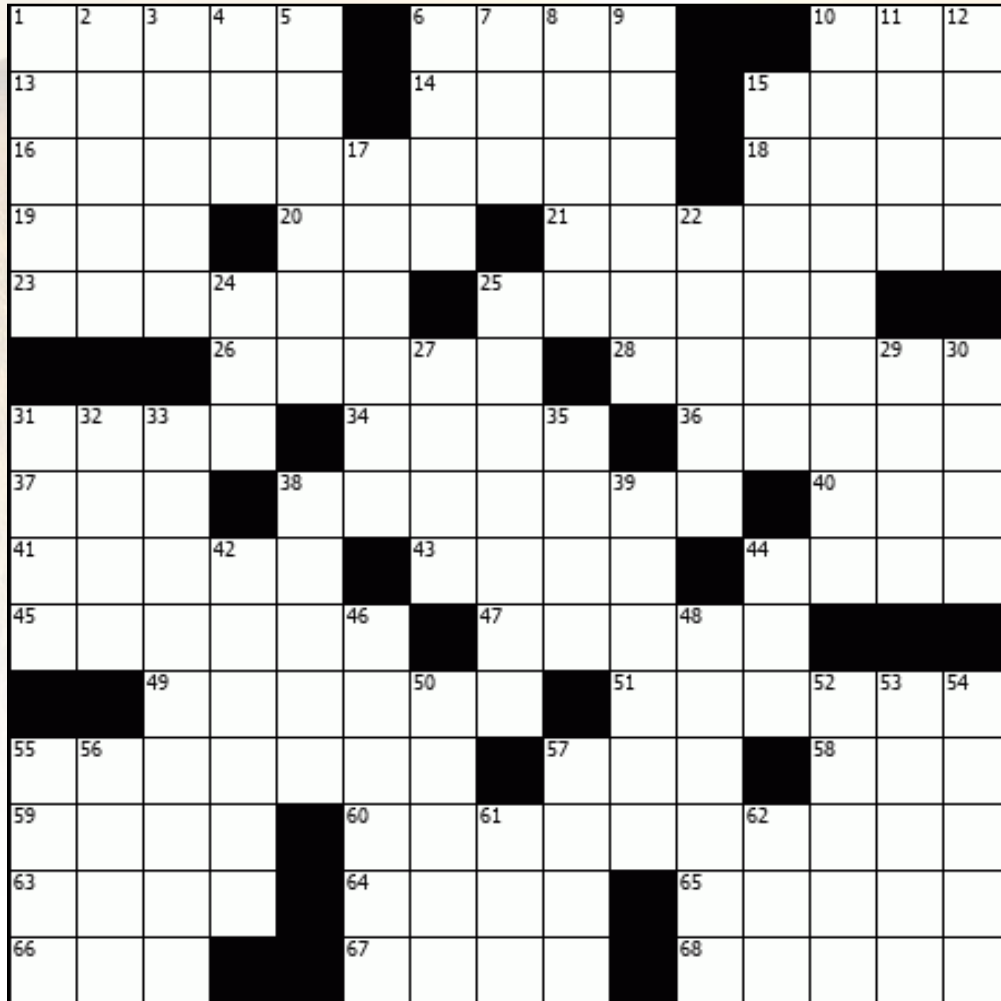

ONLINE MEMBERSHIP UPDATE OR RENEWAL

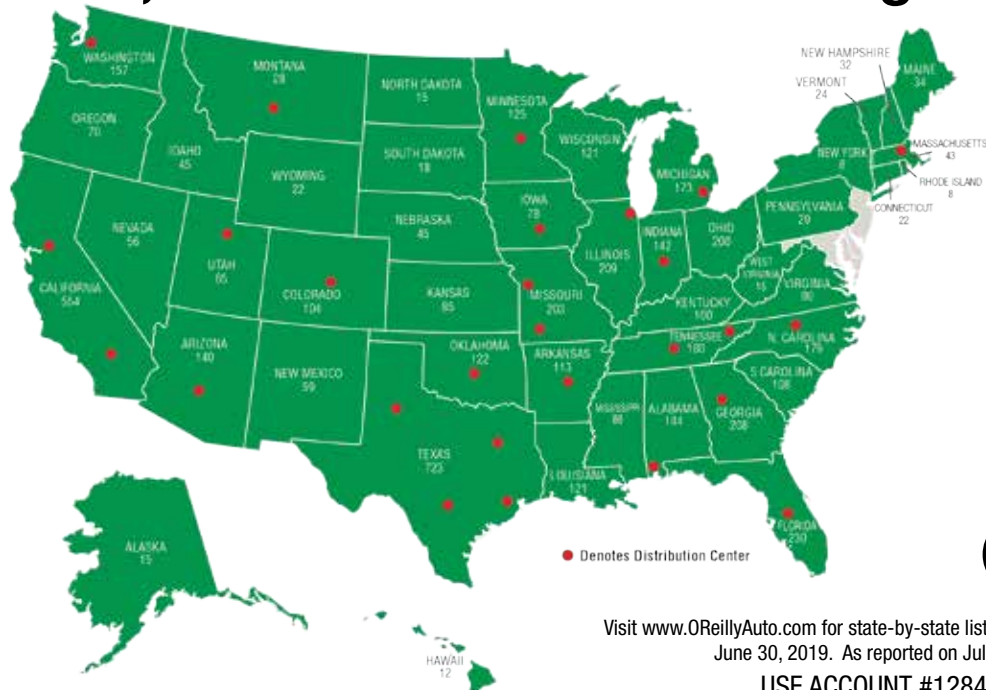
