




MARCH RALLY



- Put the pasta, water, and salt into the instant pot. Cook for 4 minutes using the manual function.
 Quick release the steam so your noodles don't get overcooked.
- 2. Gently stir in the butter until melted.
- 3. Add the cheese and milk (use 2-3 tablespoons of milk at a time, as needed, up to 1/2 cup). Add more seasoning or liquid if necessary.
- 4. For best results, let it sit for 5-10 minutes to let it thicken up a bit.

INSTANT POT CARNITAS

Prep time: 20 min Cook time: 10 minutes Servings: 4

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 1/2 pounds boneless pork shoulder roast
- 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- 1 tablespoon ground cumin
- 1 tablespoon onion powder
- 1 tablespoon garlic powder
- 2 teaspoons salt, divided
- 1 1/2 cups orange juice
- 1 lime
- 2 tablespoons chopped cilantro

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Cut the pork shoulder into 2 inch cubes and place in the pot of an electric pressure cooker.
- 2. Sprinkle with the brown sugar, cumin, onion powder, garlic powder, and 1 teaspoon of salt. Stir to coat the meat. Pour in the orange juice.
- 3. Place the lid on the pressure cook and set vent to sealing.
- 4. Cook on high pressure for 27 minutes. Let pressure release naturally, about 15 minutes.
- 5. Remove the pork from the liquid and shred with two forks.
- 6. Place meat on a metal cookie sheet and squeeze lime juice over the top of the meat. Sprinkle with the remaining salt. Taste and add additional salt, if needed.
- 7. Place under the broiler until meat is crisp on the edges, about 5 minutes, stirring occasionally.
- 8. Sprinkle meat with cilantro and serve as a filling for tacos, in a burrito, or over rice.



ONLINE MEMBERSHIP UPDATE OR RENEWAL
