

Great Service

My wife and I jumped head first into motorhoming by purchasing a 2018 Newmar Ventana on a Freightliner Custom Chassis. To say I was overwhelmed would be an understatement. Before too long I noticed the front leaning to the right by 2".

I contacted Freightliner in Gaffney, SC and was put in touch with Bobby Scruggs, who told me about the Freightliner Custom Chassis Owners Club and the advantages of attending the rally in Myrtle Beach, SC. Moreover, he explained the Camp Freightliner class and spent over an hour on the phone with me talking me off the ledge and assuring me Freightliner would be there to fix the problem.

Rather than driving three hours to the factory in Gaffney, SC, I decided to take my coach 30 minutes from me to Velocity Truck Center in Greensboro, NC. I arrived at 7:00 AM and was greeted immediately by Chris Kimsey in the service department. Within four hours Chris called me and explained the problem. It appeared the axle had shifted to the right causing the airbags to be off-centered. Chris then put me in touch with Nelson in the body shop, who was tasked with putting the front axle back in place and aligning it. Nelson was patient and kind as he explained he would get it on the alignment machine as quickly as possible and make sure everything was within tolerance.

When I got home, I still had questions despite the immense amount of time everyone at Velocity had given me. I emailed Bobby Scruggs on the off chance he would see my email and respond. Not only did he respond to me immediately, but he was teaching a dealer training class and had a Velocity student who actually followed up on my chassis. He confirmed what needed to be done and explained the process.

You can imagine the roller coaster ride I have been on since making this significant purchase and discovering what I feared would be extensive repairs. The repairs have not been completed and I haven't gotten a final bill, but I am confident based on these organizations and outstanding employees that everything will be handled professionally, competently and fairly.

Again, thank you to your organization and all of those involved.

Tampa Electric provides the warm water manatees love. Their Big Bend Power Station in Apollo Beach circulates water from Tampa Bay for cooling, then sends the water flowing clean and warm back into the bay. In the winter months, the manatees leave colder waters to return to this warm and welcoming refuge. ABOUT YUMA

Yuma lies in the southwest corner of Arizona on the banks of the Colorado River and is near the Mexican and Californian borders. It is the largest city in Arizona outside the metro areas of Phoenix and Tucson. FCOC PRESIDENT STEVE BERTLING



- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/3 cup white sugar
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 egg, beaten
- 1/4 cup canola oi
- 1 cup milk

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Preheat oven to 400°F (200°C). Grease muffin pan or line with paper muffin liners.
- 2. In a large bowl, mix together corn meal, flour, sugar, baking powder and salt.
- 3. Add egg, oil and milk; stir gently to combine.
- 4. Spoon batter into prepared muffin cups.
- Bake at 400°F (200°C) for 15 to 20 minutes, or until a toothpick inserted into a muffin comes out clean.

BEST SOFT CHRISTMAS COOKIES

Prep time: 20 min Cook time: 15 minutes Servings: 48

INGREDIENTS:

- 3 3/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 1/2 cups white sugar
- 1 cup margarine, softened
- 2 eggs
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Sift flour, baking powder, and salt together in a medium bowl; set aside.
- 2. Beat sugar and margarine in a large bowl with an electric mixer until smooth. Beat first egg into butter mixture. Beat second egg into mixture along with vanilla extract; add flour mixture and stir until dough is just combined. Wrap dough; chill in the refrigerator for 2 hours.
- 3. Preheat the oven to 400°F (200°C). Grease two cookie sheets.
- 4. Roll out dough on a clean floured surface to 1/4-inch thickness. Cut out shapes using cookie cutters; arrange them on the prepared cookie sheets. Gather scraps and repeat this step.
- 5. Bake in batches in the preheated oven until edges are golden, about 6 to 8 minutes. Cool on the baking sheet briefly before removing to a wire rack to cool completely.




