

BEST PLANTS FOR RV LIVING

Air Plants (Tillandsia) – Zero dirt, mess-free.



GREENERY FOR EVERY ADVENTURE

Your RV is more than just a vehicle-it's home! And home should feel fresh, inviting, and full of life. Whether you're chilling by the beach, parked in a scenic forest, or just boondocking in the desert, a little greenery goes a long way in making your space feel special. So, grab some plants and bring the beauty of nature inside the ride too.



INGREDIENTS:

- 2 pounds carrots peeled and sliced diagonally
- 1/2 cup sliced almonds
- 2 cloves garlic minced
- 1/4 cup extra-virgin olive oil

- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon black pepper
- 2 tablespoons cider vinegar
- 2 teaspoons honey

- 1 package (4 ounces) Danish blue cheese, crumbled
- 1/2 cup dried cranberries
- 3 cups arugula

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Begin by preheating your oven to 400 degrees F.
- **2.** Mix the carrots, almonds, and garlic on a baking sheet. Drizzle with olive oil and sprinkle with salt and pepper. Toss to coat and spread out in an even layer.
- **3.** Roast the carrots for about 30 minutes until they are soft and the edges start to turn brown. Stir them twice while roasting.
- **4.** Remove from the oven and cool to room temperature.
- **5.** Transfer the carrots to a large bowl.
- 6. Drizzle with vinegar and honey. Toss to coat.
- 7. Add the blue cheese, cranberries, and arugula. Mix gently to combine.

TUSCAN ARTICHOKE SALAD

SALAD INGREDIENTS:

- 10 ounces cherry tomatoes cut in half
- 1/2 medium red onion thinly sliced
- 1 12-ounce jar of marinated artichoke hearts, strained from water/marinade
- 1 15-ounce can of cooked chickpeas, strained, rinsed, and dried (about 1 1/2 cups cooked chickpeas)
- 2 tablespoons fresh basil, cut into thin strips
- 2 tablespoons fresh chives, finely diced
- 1 tablespoon capers

TUSCAN VINAIGRETTE:

- 1 1/4 cup olive oil
- 2 tablespoons red wine vinegar
- 1 teaspoon dried parsley
- 1/4-1/2 teaspoon salt, add more or less to taste
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder or 1 garlic clove, finely minced
- 1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. First, prep the veggies, herbs, and chickpeas. Cut the cherry tomatoes in half, thinly slice the red onion, finely chop the chives, and cut the basil into long thin strips. Stain the artichoke hearts from the liquid they are sitting in and set aside. Lastly, strain and rinse the canned chickpeas and then pat them dry before adding to the salad.
- 2. Next, make the Tuscan vinaigrette. Add the olive oil, red wine vinegar, dried parsley, salt, garlic powder, and black pepper to a bowl and whisk together.
- 3. To finish, put everything together. Add the chopped tomatoes, red onion, chives, basil, marinated artichoke hearts, chickpeas, capers, and vinaigrette to a bowl.
- **4.** Mix until all the veggies are coated.
- **5.** Serve immediately or chill for 1-2 hours for an even better flavor. Enjoy!

ONLINE MEMBERSHIP UPDATE OR RENEWAL






